(Driver Load, Unload, Assist)	increments at \$25/quarter hour
Driver Count	\$100 Flat plus applicable driver detention charges.

	have another driver enroute.)
Container clean out	\$100 to clean out any dunnage or product left behind before container can be
	returned to the rail.
